2022 Overview

2022 was a successful year at Lake Superior Life Care and Hospice. Hospice care continues to be the core of our business, serving patients and families within roughly a 40-mile radius around Marquette. Established in 1979, 2022 marked our 43rd year of providing services to the community.



Mission & Vision

Mission: Providing exceptional end-of-life care for patients and their families.

Vision: To continue being the preferred hospice provider for patients and their families through clinical excellence, quality service, outreach, advocacy, and collaboration.



By the Numbers

In 2022, our average daily census was **25** and we served **162** hospice patients and their families.

2022 average length of stay: **78 days** Median length of stay: **22 days**




